The 2025 Global High-Level Think Tank Forum for Science & Technology Innovation was held successfully. This achievement would not have been possible without your invaluable support and active participation.

The Global High-Level Think Tank Forum for Science & Technology Innovation was jointly hosted by Ministry of Science and Technology of the People's Republic of China and the People's Government of Beijing Municipality.
